Together with the Ulumbarra Foundation, ACA are very pleased to offer 2 scholarships to student-artists that have been accepted into the ACA in 2021
All student artists are eligible to apply for these scholarships; details for application are outlined below.

Selection Criteria

- 1 Applicants must be enrolled at Bendigo South East College at the time of application submission
- 2 Applicants must have been offered a position in Bendigo South East's Academy of Creative Arts for 2021 (this can include the Alumni and Step Up programs)
- 3 Applicants must submit a written application to holsworth.cynthia.j@edumail.vic.edu.au prior to the due date. Late applications will not be assessed

Submission Criteria

1. All applications must be in written form (hand written or digital)
2. Application must address the following elements:
 - i. Your background in the arts
 - ii. Your goals, both educational and artistic
 - iii. Your involvement in community activities and your positive contributions to these
 - iv. What would a scholarship mean for your development as an artist
3. Applications must not exceed 500 words
4. Must be emailed to holsworth.cynthia.j@edumail.vic.gov.au prior to the due date
5. All applicants must be willing to assist in promotions relating to the ACA and Ulumbarra Foundation partnership (eg. Social media posts and publications)

Timeline

- 19th October Scholarship Announcement to students and applications open
Including Grade 6 students (2021 Year 7)
- 16th November Applications Close
- 23rd November Selections made
- 7th December 2020 ACA Showcase and Induction Evening; Scholarships presented

Inclusions

- The Ulumbarra Foundation will contribute the full 2021 fee for the Academy of Creative Arts for chosen student artists (\$1,000 tbc)
